This service is available to all our dispensing patients, if you wish to take advantage of it, please complete and return the slip below

IT WILL NOT BE POSSIBLE TO ALLOW DELIVERY OF REFRIGERATED ITEMS OR CONTROLLED DRUGS THESE WILL NEED TO BE COLLECTED FROM OUR PHARMACY.

We ask that patients who normally pay for their prescriptions consider having a pre-payment certificate, forms are available on request from our dispensary, current charges are 3 months-£29.10; 12 months £104.00.

HOW WILL IT WORK?

When we receive your signed acceptance form we will mark your prescription with the Shop / Post Office Code for your area.

Our dispensers will make up the items, enclose your prescription counterfoil and place in a prescription bag; the bag will be sealed and labeled with your name and address. A delivery slip with your name and address will be attached to your prescription bag.

The items will be delivered to participating PO/Shops each day.

All you need to do is go to your participating shop and ask for your repeat prescription. You will be asked to confirm your name and address; this will be checked against the label on the bag of goods. You will be asked to sign the delivery slip, and then the bag containing your medication will be handed, unopened, to you. Your repeat counterfoil will be **inside** the bag. If you have any queries about what has been dispensed you will need to refer back to our dispensary on **01326 372502**

All prescriptions will be for 28 day periods; this is in line with government recommendations.

The prescriptions will not need your signature; we are authorized to deal with delivered prescriptions on your behalf.

When you need to order your next repeat medication you can either send your request by post to the surgery or place it in a sealed envelope and left at the participating outlet for collection by our delivery driver. We ask that you use a sealed envelope to safeguard your confidentiality.

We will aim to deliver your prepared medication within 72 hours of receipt of your medication request.

FOR THOSE WHO NORMALLY PAY?

It is preferable that persons in receipt of regular medication have a pre-payment certificate, the cost of these is currently £29.10 for three months and £104.00 for Twelve months, and these forms are available from our dispensary at your request

Patients who do not have a pre-payment certificate will need to forward their payment together with their prescription request in a sealed envelope – cheques are preferred, made payable to 'Hendras at Penryn'. The current charge is £8.05 per item.

FOR THOSE WHO DO NOT PAY?

Patients are normally exempt from payment when they reach 60. Patients under 60 who are exempt will need to provide us with evidence of their exemption. Please forward your proof, which will be kept on file. We will need evidence of your exemption at each renewal period – please remember to let us have your details. The government carries out their own inspection process and levy fines on persons falsely claiming.
